Dear Business Partner,

We are reaching out to request your serious and concrete participation in the urgent actions required to address the challenges related to climate change.

As you are aware, Atm has been committed to this cause for some time, starting with the Full Electric plan, which involves converting our entire fleet from diesel to electric. Alongside this significant industrial transformation, we have also implemented a Sustainability Policy with clearly defined pillars that outline our strategy and measurable KPIs.

To achieve our sustainability goals, it is essential to include our entire supply chain. In this regard, and in line with the new European regulations on non-financial reporting (CSRD), we have begun the process of calculating Scope 3 emissions, which are the carbon emissions produced by our supply chain.

To assist us in this effort, we have initiated a collaboration with EcoVadis, a global corporate social responsibility (CSR) rating company based on international standards, which will help us achieve this objective.

For this reason, we kindly ask you to register your company on the EcoVadis platform in order to calculate your emissions using a consistent and recognized method. We would like to clarify that the effort required for this process will be borne by your company, and participation is entirely voluntary. We believe this minimal investment will provide future benefits for your company as well.

Through this evaluation, you will have the opportunity to calculate your emissions and identify both your strengths and areas for improvement, fostering mutual benefits and continuous improvement. You will also be able to share your rating with all of your business partners.

Gradually, Europe will require all companies, including non-listed ones, to calculate their direct and indirect emissions (Scope 1 and 2). Therefore, we believe that starting this process together, using a globally recognized platform, will be beneficial for all parties.

Starting next year, companies like Atm will be required to calculate Scope 3 emissions, which include those derived from various factors, including the supply chain. This obligation is imposed by the new European directive and must be fulfilled by the end of the year, in time for the next reporting deadline in February 2025.

Your participation is crucial to the sustainable management of our supply chain and will be a key factor in our process of selection and review of future suppliers.

We thank you for the time dedicated to strengthening our partnership and for participating in this strategic initiative for a more sustainable future for Atm and the Planet.
